Description	Risk	Action/Notes
Fairfield is situated off the High Street and can be approached from Star Lane, Fairfield and the railway station car park	Collision with vehicle in Star Lane, or crossover from Summerfields to Stonegate	None, as the access points are all cul-de-sacs. Dog-leg barrier installed in path
Children's play area has a variety of play equipment	Vandalism	Play area inspected weekly by the Parish Council, litter-picked weekly by contractors and annually inspected by RoSPA. Faults remedied by the Parish Council
Playing field	Vandalism Broken glass	Contractors litter-pick and inspect weekly Faults remedied by the Parish Council
Skate park	Vandalism Broken glass	Contractors litter-pick and inspect weekly Faults remedied by the Parish Council
Whole area	Dog fouling	No dog warden at Brentwood Borough Council Signage and bins in place
Pond area	Drowning	'Deep Water' warning signage in place
Two closed churchyards	Leaning headstones	Push Test (terminology) If headstones are at 45-degrees, they are to be laid down, if possible
Grounds	Uneven due to wildlife	Grounds maintained by contractor and cricket club who also carry out safety checks (ie pests, litter etc) The Parish Council is to take any necessary action
Hedges and overhanging branches	Injury	Contractor to take remedial action, as and when instructed by Parish Council
Trees	Breaking/falling	Contractor to take remedial action, as and when instructed by Parish Council
